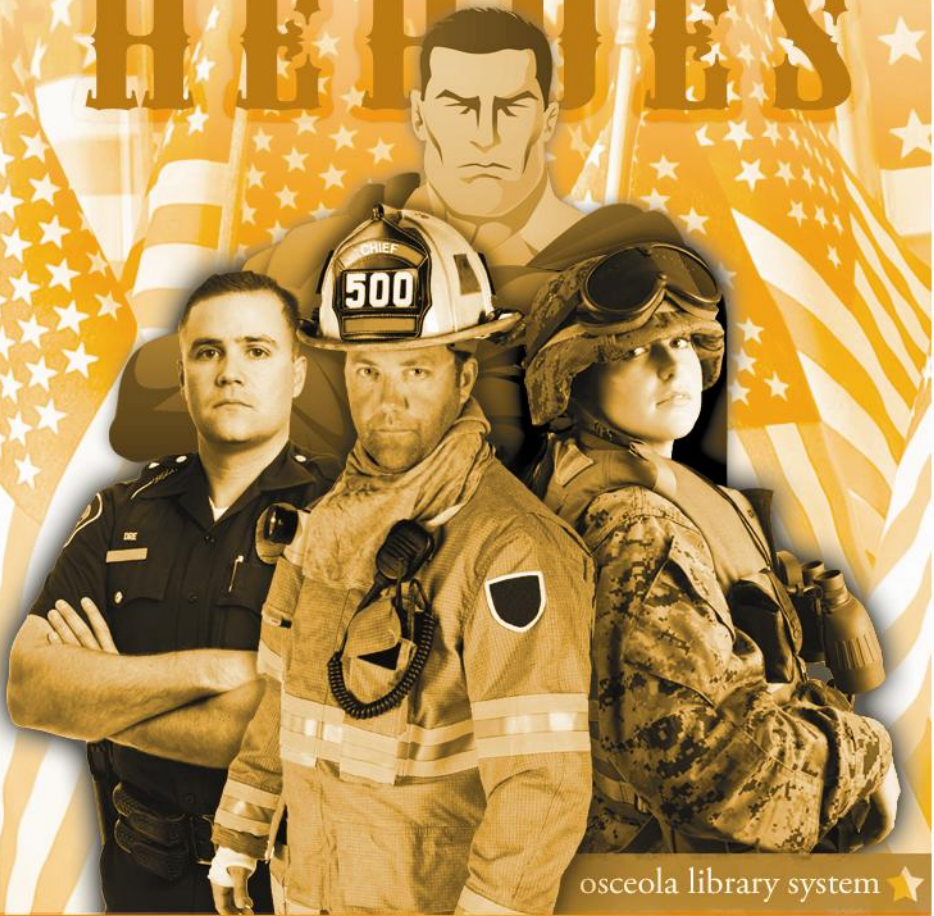

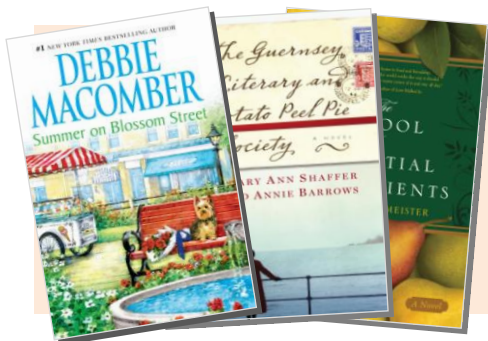

StorytimeCourtesies

- Leave the room for a break if a child becomes restless, and rejoin the group later.
- Encourage children to be nice to their neighbors.
- Be responsible for the child's safety by not leaving the child unattended.
- Model good Storytime behavior by demonstrating good manners and remaining silent during the program unless participating in the activities.
