Supplies Needed:

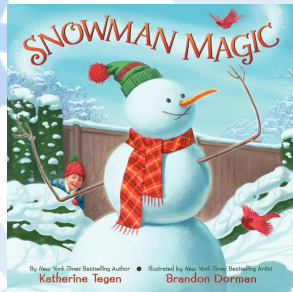
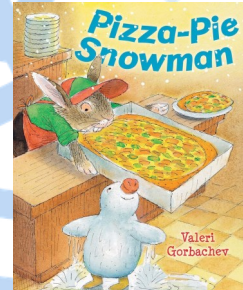
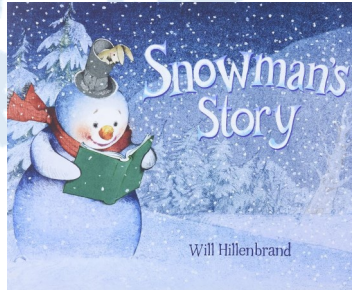
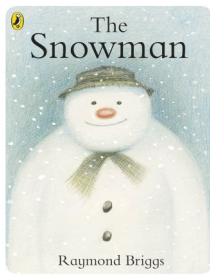
- Scissors

Direction:

1. Cut the white paper into squares or rip them into desired shape.
2. Glue the white pieces of paper to the blue construction paper.
3. Cut out eyes and mouth using black paper, cut out a triangle for the snowman's nose using the orange paper, and 2 rectangles with the brown paper for the arms.
4. Paste the eyes, nose, mouth, and arms to your snowman masterpiece!
